A buddying system has also been implemented where the new panel members are paired with existing panel members. This will assist with continuous development.


This increase in panel members will allow us to increase our panel sitting days and in turn make more decisions on applications for redress.

Last year we delivered a number of online engagement sessions where we took you through information about Redress Scotland as well as gave insight to our panel sitting days.


After feedback from these engagement sessions we have decided to host more focused engagement sessions on partuclar topics or subjects that you would like more information on.
